Kawartha Lakes Food Source distributed \$520,710 worth of non-perishable food items in 2009 to our member agencies. This was an increase of 6.5% over previous year.
Over 24,000 litres of milk, 3,040 dozen eggs, meat products, vegetables, frozen food and bread were also disbursed during the year.
The number of people served increased by 4.7%.

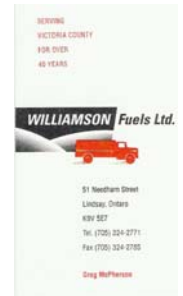
Operators were accepting silent auction bids for 3 grand prizes courtesy of BOB FM, Williamson Fuels and Whitetail Golf & Country Club Estates.
