The bulk of KLFS food supply (about 80%) comes from grocery store reclamation – food that is discarded by grocery stores and collected and distributed to food banks across the province through organizations like the Food Source.

Over recent months we at KLFS have seen a significant decline in the volume of food coming to us from reclamation. This is a concern to the Food Source and its members given the continuing need for food in our community.

Caressant Care, Mary Street & McLaughlin locations heard about our concern and held a month long food drive to help alleviate this shortage.
